All who drive through Walden Lane are familiar with the holding pond, across the road from the mailboxes. Home of the famous beavers, at one time! But, did you know that there is a second, smaller pond behind 40-42 Walden? This pond is more of a drainage, rather than a holding pond. Altogether, there are five drain pipes to handle the water coming down from all of the units on the south side of Walden Lane. Peter has done an excellent job of cleaning this pond out of all growth, thus insuring that the water can continue into the wetlands. Note the pipe at the bottom of the photo. This pipe is from 40-42 Walden. In time, it had become buried in silt and growth and the owners had to replace about 50 ft. of very clogged pipes. Peter has carved a wide path to the pond and maintains it. Feel free to take a walk down to admire his work. Thanks, as always, Peter, for a job well done.
